	ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP: Available to any piano teacher interested in promoting excellence in music education and furthering their knowledge of music through TPTA. Associate members may attend all general meetings, have the right to vote, and have the right to hold office.
	ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP: Available to Associate Members who have completed the Certification Program, which involves presenting three student performances for evaluators (see the Membership Chairperson for the written guidelines). Active members have the right to vote during general business meetings, hold office, and enterstudents into TPTA performances and events. To maintain status as an Active Member, at least four TPTA meetings must be attended each year (or a written request to be excused from the attendance requirement should be annually submitted, in writing). Note: The requirement for completion of the Certification Program may be waived for full-time university piano faculty or for teachers who are transferring from a professional group of another city.
	EMERITUS MEMBERSHIP: Available to those who have been active teachers for at least 20 years and are retired or semi-retired from teaching. Emeritus members are relieved of any attendance requirements and of the right to hold office, but shall maintain the right to vote.
